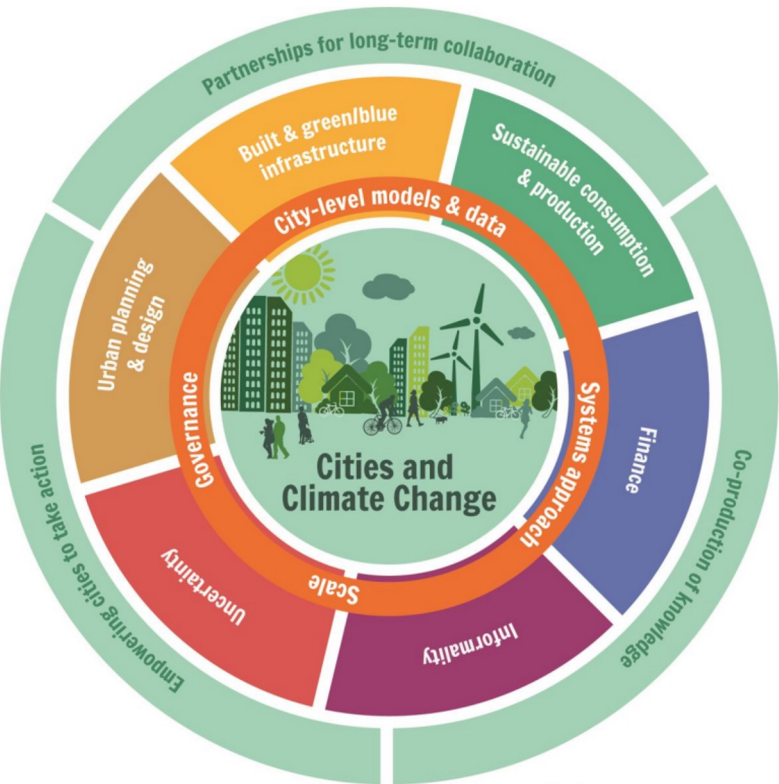

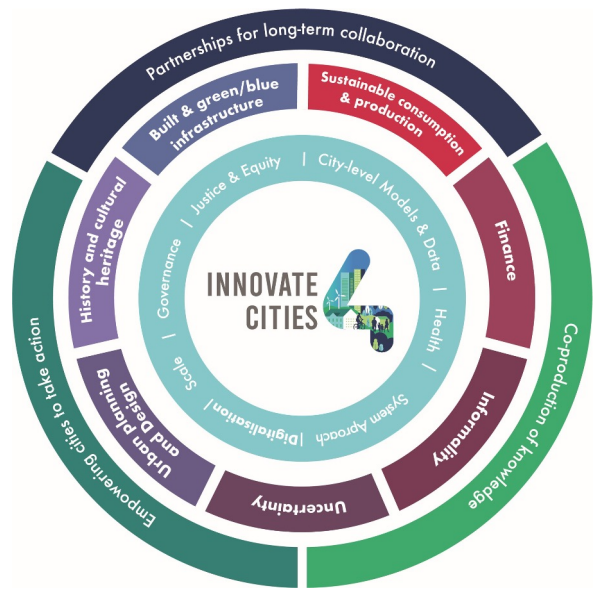

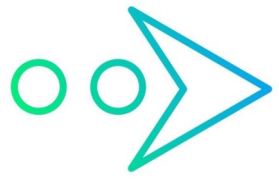
GRAA updated wheel in 2021

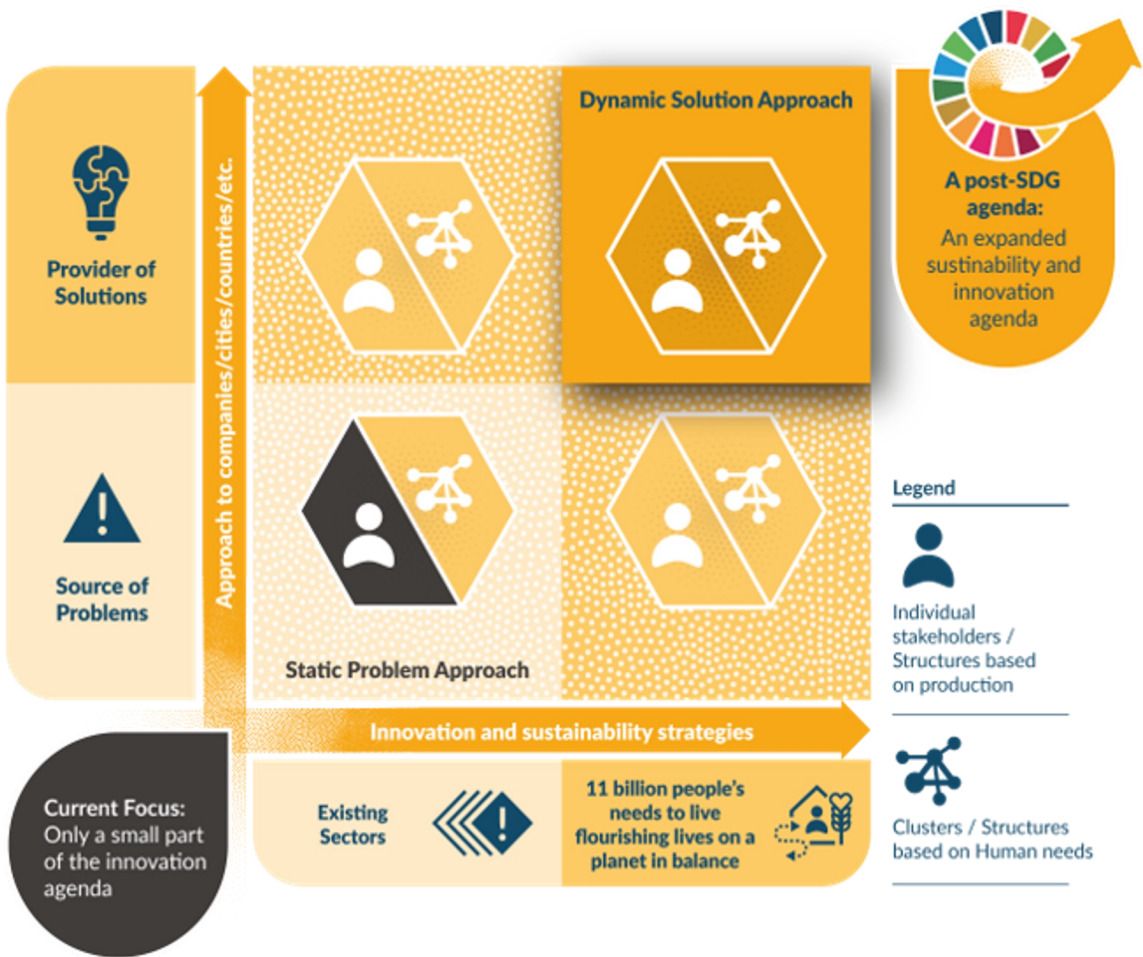


Updated GRAA wheel in 2021

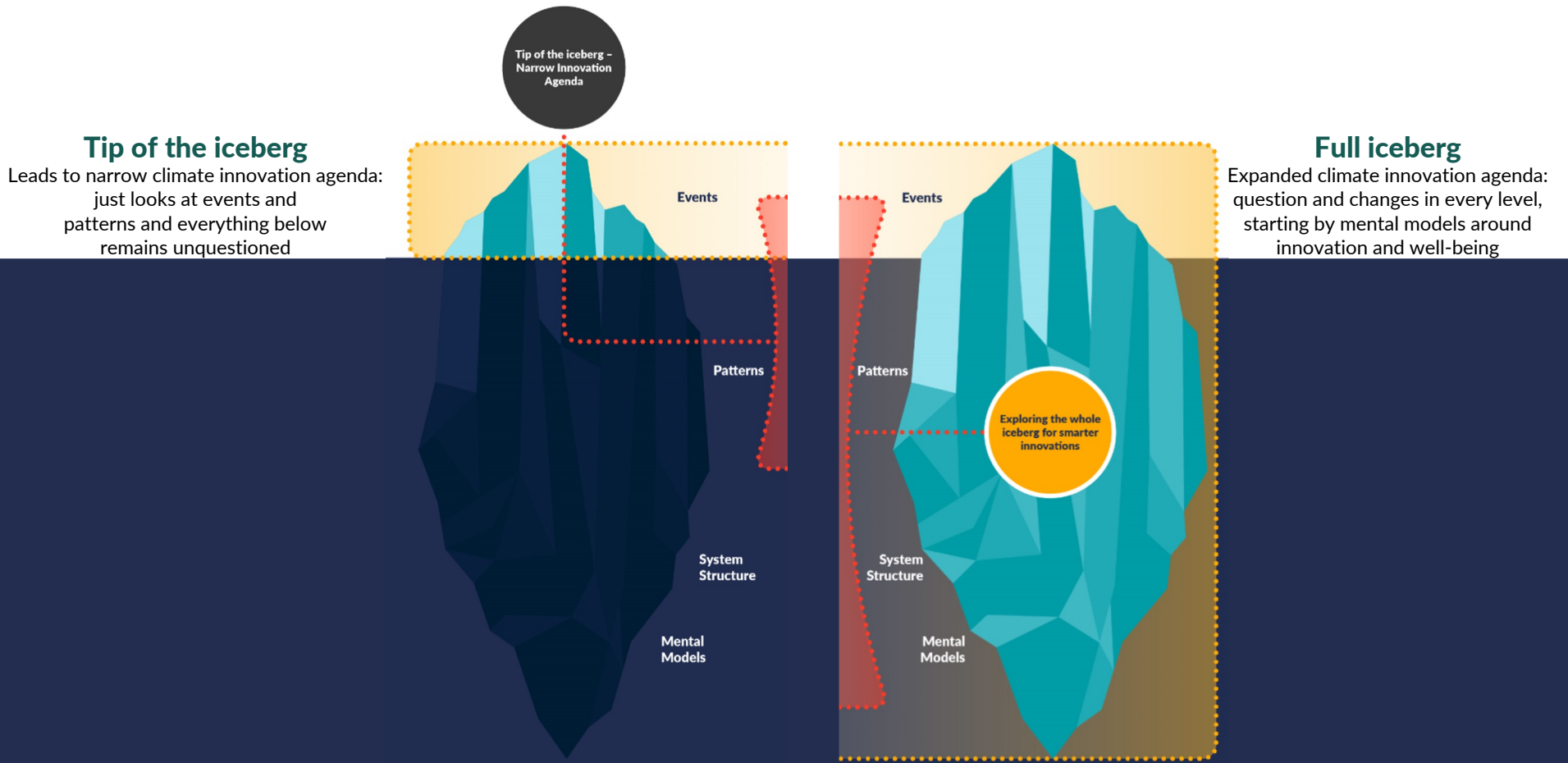
Updated GRAA wheel in 2024: Outcome of Innovate4Cities 2024 and Informed by ICLEI World Congress 2024

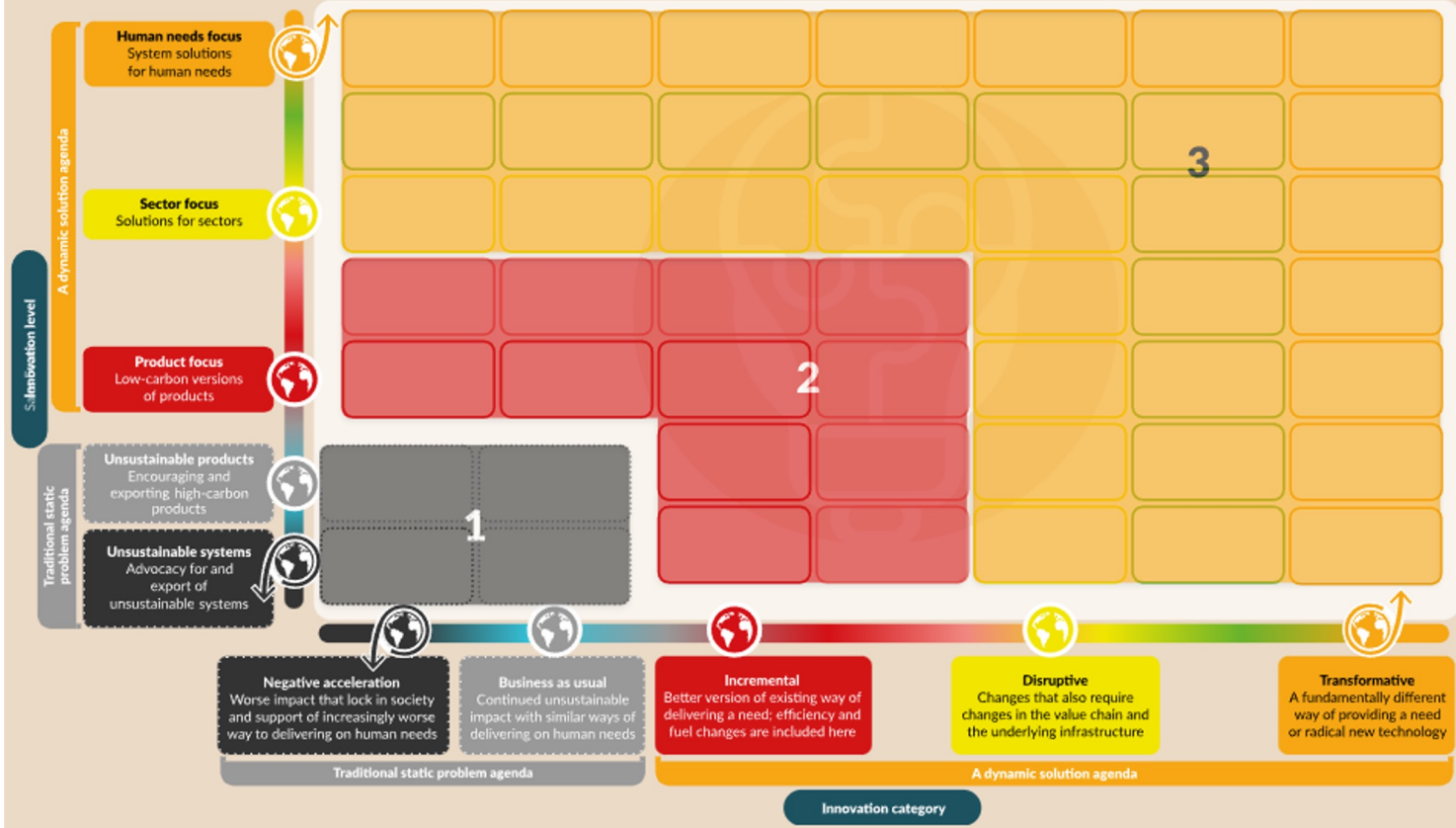
